An update from the Kingston NanoFabrication Lab – August 26, 2015

Good day,

You are receiving this email as a registered user of KNFL, or a user's supervisor. I wanted to give you a quick update of the activities at KNFL. As we continue to commission tools and develop training programs, additional capabilities will come online. Since the announcement was made a couple weeks ago that KNFL was beginning to charge for its services, the IMP Maskless Photolithography System and Physical Vapour Deposition System (with electron-beam evaporator) have become available for use and charges will begin to be applied for those tools beginning Sept. 1. In addition, we have had a stylus profilometer installed in the cleanroom, which is now available for use and will be included in the general lab access fee. A special thanks to Dr. Carlos Escobedo for making this tool available at KNFL. Further updates will be issued as new tools are installed and commissioned, or as significant procedural changes are implemented.
